However, pertinent information which has not been previously submitted is set out below: Copies of a press release dated June 12, 1947, obtained from NELSON FRANK, Staff writer, "New York World Telegram", reflect that JOHN H. IAWSON spoke at the Artists Fight Back meeting at Manhattan Center, New York City, on June 11, 1948. The subject of his dissertation was "Artists Fight Back", Confidential Informant, ND 426 advised on March 15. 1944 that LAWSON was Secretary of the American Society for Technical Aid to Spanish Democracy in February, 1937. ND 426 advised on November 6, 1943, that LAWSON served as a member of the MarxBedacht Birthday Committee, BEDACHT is former head of the IWO and member of the Communist Party.
