Former LA 3402-S, who in the past has acted as business agent for JOHN HOWARD LAWSON and continues to have regular contacts with him, was alerted on 6/22/64 to immediately furnish any information concerning the possibilities of foreign travel of either LAWSON or STEVENSON, with whom informant is also acquainted. Recheck with former LA 3402-S on 6/30/64 and 7/1/64 reflects no information received at this time to indicate either LAWSON or STEVENSON will be traveling abroad. Any information received to the contrary will be immediately furnished the Bureau and New York. (X)(u)
