On April 3, 1962, Mrs. ISABEL HAESCHE, District Commercial Secretary, Southern New England Telephone Company, 300 George Street, New Haven, Connecticut, who has furnished reliable information in the past and whose identity should be protected per request, advised that New Haven telephone number UN 5-4189 is listed for WILLIAM WINNICK, 1220 Chapel Street, New Haven. According to telephone company records, the above is a business telephone for WINNICK, who is in the insurance business.

On February 14, 1961, NH 405-S, who has furnished reliable information in the past, identified WILLIAM WINNICK as Financial Secretary of the Connecticut Branch, Socialist Workers Party (SWP). On April 11, 1961, NH 405-S identified WINNICK as Secretary and member of the Executive Board, New Haven Chapter, The Fair Play for Cuba Committee.

Characterizations of the SWP, as well as the Fair Play for Cuba Committee, are attached hereto. Sources utilized in the Fair Play for Cuba Committee characterization are NY 711-S and CG 5824-S*, respectively. Sources used in the Socialist Workers Party, Connecticut Branch, are NY-2440-S* and NH 405-S respectively.

It is requested that New York furnish New Haven with an appropriate characterization of subject, for use in connection with reporting the activities of WILLIAM WINNICK.
