

A characterization of the FPCC appears in the Appendix attached hereto.

On May 29, 1962, NY T-2, another government agency, advised that they had learned that subject had furnished the address of ANDRE MARTINSONS, 297 East 10th Street, New York City, as a safe address for people in Central and South America to use in communicating with him.

According to information furnished by NY T-14, ANDRE MARTINSONS is a former full time employee of the FPCC.



On May 24, 1962, NY T-1 advised that subject told him on May 23, 1962, that he had a press card as a United Nations (UN) correspondent for "Bohemia", a Cuban magazine.

Connections with the FPCC

On May 11, 1962, NY T-3 advised that at a meeting of the Executive Committee of the FPCC in Chicago, Illinois, it was announced that subject had written a letter urging the group to cooperate in any action in opposition to the House Committee for Un-American Activities.
