 OFF TO MEXI FOR PERSONAL MEETING LITENSOR TO PRESENT NEW
 DOCUMENTARY EVIDENCE, PERHAPS IMMEDIATELY BEFORE INTERNATIONAL
 MEETING? SAME VENEZUELAN REP COULD HOLD PRESS CONFERENCE AFTER
