1. KIVA/1, a high level Communist Party penetration in South America, recently returned from the Soviet Union where he was a student at a new CPSU school for foreign Communists. (KODESK/ICG is preparing a study on the new school which will be forwarded to you separately. KIVA/1 was in the Soviet Union from September 1962 through June 1963. During his debriefing on other Latin Americans he met at the same training school, the following information was provided on Mexicans and is being furnished you for your records:

Rigoberto *CALIX, who received a letter from O. Salinas R., Chichen-Itza #117-D, Col. Vertis-Marvarte, Mexico 13, D.F. The letter referred to Rigoberto as "son". Ernesto DELGADO (believed to have been a pseudonym), Carlos PINEDA (believed to have been a pseudonym) and J. ROMAN, who received a letter from Emiliana, Libertad 908-Z, Guadalajara, Mexico.

2. If the Station can positively identify any of the above-listed Mexicans who took the high-level training course in the Soviet Union, please inform Headquarters so that appropriate name checks can be conducted. Any of them would, naturally, be considered loyal party members and would probably be fairly important in the Communist Party structure in Mexico.
