SUBJECT: OSWALD-- Nosenko

1. On 26 July [redacted] called to my attention an aspect of NOSENKO's information which must be thoroughly examined when we attempt to assess analyze (sic) NOSENKO's story about the OSWALD case. [redacted] has been reading all the latest from N(OKENKO) re OSWALD and it is his impression there are not only gaps in the info from the standpoint that N(OKENKO) should know more but also some aspects which don't ring true.

2. [redacted] recently received from [redacted] information about the activities of [redacted] contact with a British source [redacted] to be reliable. It is [redacted]'s impression (I have not examined this case thoroughly) that the Soviets have continued to try to make SHIRAKOVA look clean, [redacted] [redacted] [redacted] and is only an [redacted] thesis. This is questionable on its surface. At any rate, the controlled British source and SHIRAKOVA visited Mme TOUSSAULT (sic) at her home museum where SHIRAKOVA had a visible (sic) reaction when seeing OSWALD's name [redacted] [redacted] (sic) was entirely innocent on the part of the source - British, i.e., it was not done deliberately. SHIRAKOVA's reaction indicated suspicion that this was a provocation
