This is to acknowledge your letter of 3 October 1995 to Director of Central Intelligence Deutch advising of the Assassination Records Review Board's most recent formal determinations with respect to CIA records.

We have reviewed again the 61 documents which the Board has decided to release now, either fully or with some portions postponed. Please advise the Board that the Agency does not plan to appeal to the President for additional postponements with respect to these documents.

We note that for five of the documents, further review will be necessary by the year 2005 to determine if additional information can be released then. In the meantime, we are prepared to discuss with the Board and your staff any issues that may arise regarding the assassination records.
