Action : As indicated

1. The salary paid to CISCO-26 in Caracas would, at least as a beginning salary, be somewhat too high for Mexico, although the Station is prepared to raise his salary after six months or so, provided the quality and quantity of the information provided by him is sufficient. Assuming that no part of his salary will have to be diverted to ICINMATE, it is suggested that he start off in Mexico with a monthly salary of US\$ 150.00. That amount should allow him to live reasonably comfortably and pay his normal school expenses.

2. In accordance with Reference A, it is assumed that CISCO-26 expects to enter the spring semester here. Please keep Mexico informed of the progress he is making toward changing his residence from Venezuela to Mexico. At the appropriate time, Mexico will provide contact and recognition instructions.
