Memorandum for Chief -

At 10:45 a.m. today while speaking on the phone with SAIC Shields, Providence, on the Jacques Mari case, file 1-9-13154-S, he reported that the United States Attorney in Providence had informed him verbally that the FBI, acting on instructions from Washington, had investigated the matter of the young individual Neal Patrick Coady, who had been mistaken for a Secret Service Agent and had been allowed through police lines and later rode the follow-up car during the President's recent visit to Providence. The matter was presented to the U. S. Attorney for possible prosecution in violation of "Impersonation of a Secret Service Agent." The U. S. Attorney declined prosecution.

The U. S. Attorney further stated he was relating this information to Shields as a friend and did not want anything in writing.
