Investigation in Berlin reveals no more than Marina Oswald's name & photo were available to the Berlin press at the time Reggab first approached the Satellite Refugee Screening Center with the above information.

late-December: Reggab agreed to write to his brother-in-law in Rabat & request he locate this letter & photo.

Early January 1964: Marina Oswald denied ever knowing Reggab

Mid-January 1964: No reply from Reggab's brother-in-law. CIA station in Casablanca had provided information that while Reggab was a student in Moscow during 1960-1962 he had attended 3 meetings of a ^{Moroccan} Communist Party Cell. Due to Reggab's sighting with the Moroccan Ambassador and his trips made to Morocco during the school year at his own expense, it was believed by some Communist students that he was an informant
