GUS ALEX, AKA, AR. DAILY SUMMARY. MAIL COVER ON MAILING ADDRESS OF ALEX, EVERGREEN PARK, ILL., DISCLOSED THAT ALEX RECEIVED MAIL EARLY PART OF JUNE FROM AMERICAN NATIONAL BANK AND TRUST CO., CHICAGO. IT IS TO BE NOTED THAT ALEX HAS CHECKING ACCOUNT AT THIS BANK. PCI FRANK LA CROIX ADVISED HE OBSERVED A FEMALE ENTER THE BUILDING AT ONE ONE FIVE ZERO LAKE SHORE DRIVE YESTERDAY AND PROCEED TO THE APARTMENT OF GUS ALEX. HE STATED THAT THIS WOMAN HAS BEEN OBSERVED IN THE PAST VISITING ALEX AT HIS RESIDENCE BUT DID NOT KNOW HER IDENTITY. HE DESCRIBED HER AS A GOOD LOOKING BLONDE WOMAN, AGE ABOUT TWENTY FIVE. DR. MAURICE P. GOLDMAN, A DENTIST, INTERVIEWED AT HIS OFFICE, AT WHICH TIME HE ADVISED HE HAS BEEN PRACTICING DENISTRY AT THE SAME ADDRESS SINCE ABOUT NINETEEN THIRTY TWO AND THAT GUS ALEX WAS A FORMER PATIENT OF HIS. HE HAS NOT WORKED ON ALEX, HOWEVER, FOR THE PAST FIFTEEN YEARS. HE SAID THAT TO THE BEST OF HIS RECOLLECTION, ALEX CAME TO HIS OFFICE IN THE LATE NINETEEN THIRTIES OR EARLY NINETEEN FORTIES AS A PATIENT AND FROM CONVERSATIONS WITH ALEX HE GAINED THE IMPRESSION THAT ALEX WAS CONNECTED WITH SOME UNION DURING THE PERIOD ALEX WAS HIS PATIENT. DR. GOLDMAN STATED THAT ALTHOUGH ALEX
