COSTELLO appeared extremely upset as a result of his appearance before the Senate Rackets Committee, particularly so as a result of testimony of MOLLY BAKER, ex-wife of ROBERT BARNER BAKER, Teamsters official. MI Twice during this meeting COSTELLO expressed a desire to perpetrate bodily harm on MOLLY BAKER for the testimony given He also commented that he would "hate to be in her by her. shoes." PCI does not know whether COSTELLO is serious in his threats.
