THE TWENTY ONE FOOT BOAT HAS NOT YET HAD PROPELLERS
INSTALLED AND CONSTRUCTION NOT COMPLETED. THIS BOAT
COULD NOT HAVE BEEN USED ON MAY ONE NINE RAID, BASED
ON PRESENT CONDITION.

ONE CUBAN WAS OBSERVED AT WORK ON THE TWENTY ONE
FOOT HULL INSTALLING A PLYWOOD DECK AND COVER FOR PROM.
HE REFUSED TO IDENTIFY HIMSELF OR ADVISE AS TO OWNERSHIP
OF EITHER BOAT.

ANTONIO CUESTA, CONCEAL, PSI UNDER DEVELOPMENT WHO HAS
FURNISHED INSUFFICIENT INFO TO JUDGE RELIABILITY, ASCERTAINED
THAT JULIO CRUZ PEREZ, AN SNFE MEMBER, DEFINITELY PARTICIPATED
IN RAID, BUT HE WAS UNABLE TO ASCERTAIN IDENTITY OF OTHER FIVE
PARTICIPANTS. CUESTA DECLINED TO IDENTIFY HIS SOURCE BUT STATED
