Mr. Courtney Evans was contacted by extra duty supervisor and Mr. Evans authorized the use of the contact "mike!" He instructed that SAC Bachman be told to make sure there would be no trespass and no "phone mike" was to be used.

At 5:20 p. m., SAC Bachman was told he could use the contact "mike" under the conditions set forth by Mr. Evans and to keep the Bureau advised.
