MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD

SUBJECT: Meeting on 6 December with William D. Pawley in Miami

REFERENCE: Memorandum of 9 December with same subject.

1. Attachment A to this memorandum is a list of 19 Cubans which was prepared by Fabio Oscar FREYRE Aguilera when he accompanied Mr. Pawley to Washington on 30 November. Mr. Pawley showed this list to General Pedraza in the Dominican Republic when Mr. Pawley was there from 3 to 5 December and asked Pedraza whether he would be willing to work with any of the people named on this list. Pedraza replied that he would have no objection to any one on the list.

2. Attachment B is a similar list of 7 persons which was prepared by a Cuban associate of Mr. Pawley whom he did not wish to identify. Mr. Pawley also showed this list to General Pedraza and received the same favorable reaction from Pedraza.
