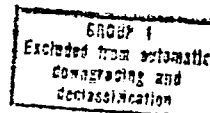
SUBJECT : US Army Personnel Who Deserted
to Iron Curtain Countries

1. A comparison of this list with the US Defector Program produced the following results. Of the 26 names, 17 were in the US Defector Program, and all of these had 201 files. We had different spellings of two surnames: ZSOFKA for ZSOPKA (?), and VALENTINI for VALENTIN. Of the 17, we had the same location information for 10, and different locations for the following:

DUTKANICZ	Russia (later returned)	USSR 1964
DAVIS	East Germany (?)	USA 1967 per FBI
WILSON	East Germany	USA 1965 per Army
LAMBIOTIE	West Berlin	USA 1966 per FBI
CAIN	West Berlin	East Germany 1968 per FBI
SVENSON	East Germany	USA 1966 per FBI
ZIEGLER	East Germany, August, 1959; returned 8/24/65	East Germany 1965 per Army
