I told him that I did not want to influence him one way or the other about not going to the Dominican Republic but wanted him to understand what the situation is.

3. Subject asked if we had had anybody try to contact him. I said no. He said that a man named Burgess, whom he does not know, has been trying to call him but that no contact has been made because they keep missing each other.
