Senate Select Committee Request (Charles W. Wiley)

1. Reference is made to a memorandum, captioned as above, dated 30 September 1975 forwarding copies of certain documents from the Office of Security files concerning Charles N. Wiley. These documents were requested by Mr. Jeffrey Mayden, Senate felect Committee Staff, who commences a review of the filey files on 20 September 1975.

2. The Office of Security has concluded a separate review of the Wiley files and has highlighted certain contents thereof to the UCL. The DCL has requested that materials concerning the following items be provided to the Senate Select Committee Independent of any Senate Select Committee Staff requests, to wit:

Lee Harvey Oswald

The filos contain a raw, unevaluated report from Wiley containing his reporting of an allagation that Lee Hervey Oswald was in Det York City in the Winter of 1962, having contact with a Cuban.

(Attached to instant memorandum, Tab A. is a copy of Wiley's original report, and attondent comments, suggesting receipt of the report circa ZO December 1963.)

Readily available public and Office of Security information concerning Oswald makes no reference to the possibility of his being in New York City in the Winter of 1962. The Warren Commission did not pursue such a line of inquiry.

There is no evidence in the Wiley files or the file of the source, Enrique Eugenie Abascal (y Berenguer), \$730543, that this infermation was processed out of the Office of Security/ Security Research Staff, to which Wiley reported the information. However, as Wiley states in the report: "I urged Abascal to go to the WBI with the information, and offered to arrange a meeting. He promised to tell them the story, and made contact through an agent (O'Brien) when he knew because of past activities."

Regarding Abascal, his Office of Security file contains the following concorning his veracity:

Office of Socurity/Security Desearch Staff memorandum dated 15 August 1965: "Abascal has for several years furnished information to SES pourco which has been proven to be utterly worthless and usually fictitions."

Office of Security/Security Research Staff memorandum dated 1% May 1965: '(Abascal) has furnished source with intelligence information which appears to be complete fabrication."

FkI letterheed weugrandum doted 37 September 1953 continued "Movinicato Democrata Cristiano (1960)" contains the following statements about Abapeal It is apparent the Office of Security/ Security Research Staff had reason to question the veracity of Abascal practuding further dissemination of the information; and that there was a reason to believe that Abascal would report the information to the EAL for their action.

Arlington House, Publishers

The files contain a raw, unevaluated report from Wiley containing his reporting of an allegation that CIA had partial control of, and once attempted full control of, Arlington House, Publishers.

(Attached to instant memorandum, Tab 8, is a copy of Wiley's original report as well as copies of attandant decuments. The files centain no further clarification of the information.)

There is no Office of Security subject file in the name of Arlington House or Arlington Mouse, Publishers. ®

From other sources, it would appear that Arlington House, Fublishers is conmatted with the conservative causes of Milliam F. Euchley and the Matlonal Moview. Buckley is a former Agency copleyee and his close connections with former Agency employee E. Moward Bunt have recently received extensive publicity. It is chalieved that numerous former Acency employees are linked with Suchley's causes, and this could be the foundation for the yumered Agency involvements ith ArlingTen Hoose

5. Your attention is again directed to the concerns of the Office of Security, as expressed in the referenced memo-randum, that the Siley file documents and all statements contained therein, even though not classified as such, be carefully and prodently handled to protect the individuals Identified therein.
