She informed me that her husband had written you the week before; that he had already sent to you your typewriter and other articles. I have you have received them by this time.

This harbor is of major importance in that it is put "Off-Bounds" to visiters from time to time. This fact would suggest that Puerto Esperansa repeives "Foreign visiters" from time to time. Foreign visiters in the form of merchant ships and tenderof what else, we cannot say.

Besides Puerte Esperansa, San Vicente, Camaricca, Caradenas and Caibarien, the names Caya Larga, Zapata Stamps, Caya Coce and Santa Lucia were mentioned repeatedly as heing port towns or cities where a great deal of construction was underway. In as much as many of these places do not have any connection with local IERA projects; it must be suggested that these "now projects" are commetted in someway with the alleged construction of new docking facilities, harbor dredging, shelters and rampways being built at the afore mentioned locations.

The Motel la Brmita and an additional metal in Vinales are built on two picturesque hill tops overloking the town of Vinales. Both motels were recently built by L.M. And while she did not speak english fluently, her can interpreted for her, and recited his words of praise for the July 26th govt. of Dr. Fidel Castro as if he knew his role by heart. It was obvious to that these two were planted there at the motel la Ermita to talk to visiting foreigners; inorder to convince them of the so-called Humanist's Intentions of the Castro govt. And I personally observed them talking with several other Americans during my short stay in Vinales.

In clesing, I might add that in Vinales, I found the worst case of human poverty and destitution than in any other part of Cuba I chanced to visit.
