2. ACCORDING TO THE SOURCE, ALVAREZ, RUIZ, GROPP, TABANKIN AND ZINN WERE WILLING TO TRAVEL THROUGHOUT EUROPE AFTER THE CONFERENCE TO ADDRESS ANTI-VIETNAM WAR MEETINGS. PAUL MAYER IS HOPING TO RAISE FUNDS FOR THE BERRIGAN BROTHERS.

3. SOURCE ALSO STATED THERE IS A TENTATIVE MEETING PLANNED FOR 14 FEBRUARY BETWEEN UNNAMED VIETNAMESE REPRESENTATIVES AND AMERICAN DELEGATES TO THE VERSAILLES CONFERENCE. THE PLACE WAS NOT SPECIFIED.
