- 1. Attached are copies of the Spanish and English versions of a propaganda booklet prepared in Communist China supporting the Negro uprisings in the United States. The Spanish version was shipped to the Peoples Party Communist in Panama and was received from a sensitive source. The English version was included with a copy of the May 1968 issue of Crusader.
- 2. The booklet, entitled, "Statement by Comrade Mao Tse-Tung, Chairman of the Central Committee of the Communist Party of China, in Support of the Afro-American Struggle Against Violent Repression," is dated 15 April 1968, a few days after the assassination of Martin Luther King. It cites the Negro struggle in the United States as part of the world struggle against the "yankee imperialists," asserts that world revolution has entered a new era, and urges all people to unite and eliminate this enemy.
