Dissemination Status of WFO-10428-1

WFO-10428-1

1. Pursuant to the discussions held in the Summer and Fall of 1961 between WFO, WFO-10428-1 and JUNE KENNEDY representatives, concerning the possible manner of action by which AMELATTER-1 might regain his citizenship, WFO has made inquiries to determine the feasibility of re-introducing a private bill in Congress, based on AMELATTER-1's past services to U.S. Army organizations.

2. NEWY has advised that AMELATTER-1 furnished them information "of minor importance"; the Bureau of Customs and the Migration Bureau had no record of AMELATTER-1. WFO, after repeated inquiries, has informed us that they cannot locate AMELATTER-1's file.

3. It would seem that a new private bill would have as little hope of success as the two previously introduced, since a strong case cannot be made for A-1's prior services, based on the weak or negative results noted above, nor is it currently possible to request a legal re-examination of the basis for WFO's action to strip A-1 of citizenship, since the file is missing.

4. It is recommended, therefore, that the best method whereby AMELATTER-1 can regain his citizenship is to apply at the nearest consulate overseas for an immigrant visa. Mexico City is the most likely place. If WFO and AMELATTER agree to do this, Headquarters will be glad to assist in expediting the visa issuance.

3. It would seem that a new private bill would have to be introduced, since the two previously introduced bills were based on AMELATT-1's prior service, based on the work of AMELATT-1's past efforts. However, it is currently possible to request a legal re-examination of the basis for the action to strip AMELATT-1 of citizenship, since the file is missing.

4. It is recommended, therefore, that AMELATT-1 can regain his citizenship is to apply at the Mexican Consulate overseas for an immigrant visa. Mexico City is the most likely point of entry, and AMELATT-1 agrees to do this. Headquarters will be glad to assist in expediting the visa issuance.
