1. Reference is made to your telephone call of 25 April 1963.

2. On that date, Agent O'HARE contacted John BARRY, the householder at (14 Eton Place, Eastchester) N. Y., to re-brief him in accordance with Headquarters instructions.

3. (BARRY) immediately apologized for not contacting any one at MFO regarding an incident which occurred on either Monday or Tuesday, 22 or 23 April. According to (BARRY,) on one of those dates the "Philadelphia Inquirer" newspaper tried to telephonically contact (BARRY) of In the absence of (BARRY) and his wife, the "Inquirer" called (BARRY's next-door neighbor, Mrs. (Jerome STOCKHAUSEN) of (12 Eton Place) and inquired about the SUBJECT.

4. Mrs. (STOCKHAUSEN) subsequently informed BARRY's wife that the "Inquirer" wanted to know such things as:

Who CARSWELL was?

Was he related to the (BARRYS?

When was the last time CARSWELL was seen at the BARRYS'?

Did the neighbor (STOCKHAUSEN) know anything about CARSWELL in view of the fact that he was supposed to have lived at 14 Eton Place

According to (BARRY), Mrs. STOCKHAUSEN informed the Inquirer" that she neither knew CARSWELL nor anything about him. He advised further that when Mrs. (STOCKHAUSEN informed Mrs. (BARRY)

of the all, she expressed interest in what was going on, since the daily papers contained references to CARSWELL's release and his employment by CIA.

- 6. (BARRY) reported that his wife advised Mrs. (STOCKHAUSEN) that the SUBJECT was a friend of her husband, of John BARRY, and that he, the SUBJECT, traveled a lot and merely used (BARRY's) place to leave some clothes and occasionally receive mail.
 - 7. It is noted that in January 1961, items in the newspaper concerning CARSWELL's arrest by the Cubans listed his address at (14 Eton Place) in Eastchester)
 - 8. (BARRY) was again requested to inform Agent
 O'HARE of any future contacts with him by anyone concerning
 the SUBJECT, and he again agreed to do so.
