1. MORNING MARCH MARCOS DIAZ LANZ WAS TOLD THAT INS HAD ISSUED DEPORTATION ORDERS & HE THEREFORE HE INELIGIBLE VISA WITHOUT REAPPLYING FOR REENTRY THROUGH ATTORNEY GENERAL UNDER SECTION 212 (A) (16). INS RECORDS SHOW ALIEN EXCLUSION AND DEPORTATION. INS INFO ABOVE RECEIVED MEXI CONSULATE VIA CDACID TELEGRAM DATED 10 MARCH.

2. MEXI-QUEBEC BY LOUILL HUGH WHITAKER MANNER ENTRY U.S. DIAZ SAID ENTIRE OPERATION HANDLED BY KUBARK WHICH PROVIDED TRANSPORTATION (BOAT) TO TAMPA AND FALSE PUERTO RICO DOCUMENTATION.

3. INS MEMO CALLED OFFICE MIAMI 11 MARCH WHERE PARA 1 INFO CONFIRMED. INS MAN MIAMI ADDED OTHER INFO NOW AVAILABLE WHICH CANNOT BE PASSED BY PHONE. INS MEMO REQUESTING 12 MARCH DETAILED DEPORTATION CHARGES.

4. CDACID WH EF MEXI VERY MUCH INTERESTED CASE AS RECEIVED LETTER FROM SEN SMATHERS ASKING WHO "KIDNAPING" DIAZ CASE. MR. DOLPH HORNE, ASST SUP-RATTING GENL. CALLED WASH 10 MARCH ON CDACID CHIEF'S BEHALF RE DIAZ CASE.

C/S Comment: (Stated that Diaz was still waiting for visa in Mexico. According to the Consul Diaz felt that he was "milked" of information by the United States intelligence organization and then tossed aside.)

(Stated that Marcos Diaz applied in Mexico for an immigrant visa to the United States the morning of 11 March)
