- 1. Attached to this resorandum is a copy of an article appearing in the February 1960, issue of "Science and Mechanica" magazine. Fage 2 reflects a comment to the effect that the U.S. Intelligence under wrote the development of the Identi-kit to the amount of \$87,000.
- 2. TSD/M under RD-177 and under the EARKORT Program has invested \$82,531 into the Identi-kit. Chief Bugh C. MoDONAID, who is mentioned in the article, is a cleared TSD consultent. He was initially briefed by kr. ANDERSON, TSD/EB. The Agency sponsored Kr. McDONAID's visit to Washington and arranged his trip to Homelulu, Hawaii, all in connection with the development of the Identi-kit. The Townsend Corporation, working with McDONAID, has built a number of these kits and will advise the Agency of those sold to foreign powers, etc. Mr. Courtney OWENS, Sales manager of Townsend Engineering Corporation, is a and understands the Agency's interest in the Kit. Townsend has also opened a school for Identi-kit users. Three persons from TSD have attended this school.
- 3. The TSD project engineers are very dublous that McDONALD disclosed classified information to unauthorized persons and speak highly of his. They have especially noted his eagerness to essist us on various crash-type projects of an unclassified nature.
- 4. Therefore, we have no desire to alienate his feelings. Severtheless, I would suggest that Fr. JONES, during his forthcoming visit to the West Coast, interview Mr. MoDONAID to determine, if possible, the reason for inclusion of U.S. Intelligence interest in the attached article, whether or not CIA was mentioned during his interview with the author and to further brief MoDONAID if necessary. Furthermore, the Identi-kit is expected to receive considerable publicity as the sales program is stepped up.
- 5. A copy of this memorandum is being forwarded to PSD (Atta: Robert SWENDHAR) to determine whether or not any ether components of the Agency are or have peed McDONAID (possibly contacts or RSD).
