INCIDENT Death of Daughter TIME F.M. 23 Aug. PLACE Bethesda, Md.

SUMMARY OF INFORMATION:

Mr. ⁰² Carroll Hauser, WR/Adm., called the Security Duty Office to report, for the record, the death of Mr. Phillips' daughter. Mr. Hauser stated he had no details except that the girl was killed in an automobile accident sometime last night. Mr. Phillips had notified Mr. Hauser of the accident earlier this date that additional security assistance was needed at this time. (Mr. Hauser noted that the Chief, Karassosines, DDF, was also notified. Mr. Karassosines requested that the Office of Security be advised.) Mr. Phillips is under cover for [redacted]

The Evening Star, dated 24 August, reported that Miss [redacted] Young Phillips, age 15, was killed when the car in which she was riding collided with another car on Bradley Boulevard in Bethesda. The accident occurred around midnight.
