 Citizenship Status of ANCLATTER-1

ACTION REQUIRED

1. Pursuant to the discussions held in the Summer and Fall of 1961 between Robert K. TROUCHARD and JIMMY KUSCRA representatives, concerning the possible courses of action by which ANCLATTER-1 might regain his citizenship, KUSCRA has made inquiries to determine the feasibility of re-initiating a private bill in Congress, based on ANCLATTER-1's past services to non-MERKX organizations.

2. DENNY has advised that ANCLATTER-1 furnished them information "of minor importance"; the Bureau of Customs and the Narcotics Bureau had no record of ANCLATTER-1. OACIN, after repeated inquiries, has informed us that they cannot locate ANCLATTER-1's file.

3. It would seem that a new private bill would have as little hope of success as the two previously introduced, since a strong case cannot be made for A-1's prior services, based on the weak or negative replies noted above, nor is it currently possible to request a legal re-examination of the basis for OACIN's action to strip A-1 of citizenship, since the file is missing.

4. It is recommended, therefore, that the best method whereby ANCLATTER-1 can regain his citizenship is to apply at the nearest Consulate overseas for an immigrant visa. Mexico City is the most likely place. If DENNY and ANCLATTER agree to do this, Headquarters will be glad to assist in expediting the visa issuance.
