SUBJECT: Limited Release from Secrecy Agreement--Bernard L. Barker and Eugenio R. Martines ed. W. 77

i. In preparing the letter of 18 April 1974 (copy attached) from the General Counsel to Daniel E. Schultz in response to Mr. Schultz's letter of 9 April, I obtained from Ms. Chris Hopkins, WH/COG (x-1325), copies of (1) a secrecy agreement (in Spanish) by Eugenio Rolando Martinez dated 3 April 1965, (2) an unexecuted contract (an executed copy cannot be located) between the U.S. Government and Mr. Spencer O. Terteling (Bernard L. Barker) and (3) a termination secrecy oath signed by Bernard L. Barker dated 12 August 1966. Copies of those documents are attached.

2. After discussing the matter with Mr. David Phillips, C/WH Division, I prepared the 18 April letter adding the second sentence of the first paragraph at the request of Mr. AC/WH/CCG (x-1948). After completing the letter, I coordinated it on 15 April 1974 with Mr. and agreed to send him a copy of the final.

3. On 18 April I met with Mr. Schults. I questioned him as to his intentions regarding the information he was seeking as, in the Agency's view, clearly there is no connection between the Agency's association with Messrs. Barker and Martines and the subject case. Mr. Schults explained that he, as the lawyer representing them, focie obligated to know what they did for the Agency in order that he can make the determination as to whether it is gelevant to the current trial-currently scheduled for 17 June. He monthoused that to date both Messrs. Barker and Martinos had been completely unwilling to discuss any aspect of their duties with the Agency. They had been reluctant to even acknowledge their association with the Agency. I explained the Agency's serious reservations concerning the possibility of compromise of agents and operations that are still in being. I explained that the Agency continues to have associations with some of the individuals with whom Messrs. Barker and Martinez had contact during their Agency association. Mr. Schultz seemed to appreciate this problem. Thus, in order to attempt to protect those individuals, I explained that the Agency is currently not in a position to give Messrs. Barker and Martinez blanket authorization to identify individuals with whom they had contact during their Agency association. Mr. Schultz readily acknowledged those conditions.

4. I mentioned to Mr. Schultz that if, as a result of the discussions that are now being authorized, Mr. Schultz believes that certain individuals need to be identified he can make such a narrow request to the Agency at that time. I made no guarantee that we would approve such a request, only that we would consider it in view of (1) the rationale that Mr. Schultz would offer as to his neads, (2) the possibility of publication, (3) the damage to current operations, and (4) the precedent in terms of weakening the confidence of current and potential Agency relationships.



AMSNAP-3 reported on 11 March 1971 that the charges of sale of narcotics levied on Jorge ALONSO, the son of Guillermo ALONSO Pujol (AMECRU-1), were dropped (no exact date given). Jorge was arrested 21 June along with forty others and charged with being a top figure in the heroin and cocaine distribution racket.

AMSNAP-3 stated that he had talked with a friend of his, Ray BARKER, on the morning of 11 March. BARKER told him that he had spoken to Attorney Miguel SUAREZ. SUAREZ is a law partner of Fernando FREIRE. FREIRE told SUAREZ that Jorge ALONSO had been released because all charges stemming from the 21 June arrest were dropped by the authorities. Therefore, there will be no trial,





HARPER also visited Felipe FAZOR, a well-known Guban economist who, at present, is with the Inter-American Development Bank. Harper might have also seen some Chilean dips, but this is only an interence on my part.

The other hirds on the list that I gave you were specifically tied to the Ellaberg case. They were brought up from Miami--armed--to physically discupt Ellaberghappearance before a Congressional Committee. 

Summary. Fulgencio Batista Zaldivar has an organization in Miami which is composed of a small group of his trusted followers. The main function of this group is in the field of propaganda. Between \$5,000 and \$7,000 per month of Batista's money is channeled through this group, most of which is spent in support of these activities. On Batista's instructions, the newspaper <u>Patrin</u> will adopt a more moderate line, including a friendly attitude toward the United States Government and its foreign policy. Attacks on agencies of the Government and support for RECE, with which the Batista group is making an agreement, will be published in a different newspaper. A Batista confident left the United States for Spain in January on Batista's invitation.

Source for paras, 1 to 7: Former high-level Latin American Government official who has travelled frequently throughout the Caribbean and Central America where he maintains close friendships with a wide range of military and political leaders. He is a rightist, a trained reporter and his information has been fairly reliable in the past. Because of his past and present political affiliations, it can be assumed that be is biased in favor of Batista.

1. Other trusted members of Batista's entourage include Orlando <u>Piedra</u> Negueruela, former head of the Cuban National Police, who lives at 1805 Westbrook, Apartment D, New Orleans, Lawisiana; and Atorresagasti (inu), Batista's former military aide and confidant, who is now in charge of Batista's office in Mexico.

- 2. Headers of BAR meet on an irregular basis in an office in Cobas' garage at 2770 S.W. 22nd Avenue, Miami, because Cobas, who is in poor health, does not leave his home. The group monitors news media for items of interest to Batista, particularly those items in which he is mentioned. Nembers of the group recommend items to be published, and Guerra is responsible for the proparation of a weekly report to be released to the pross and radio.
 - 3. The finances of BAR are handled by Fernandes, with the assistance of Saif. Batista provides between \$5,000 and \$7,000 (U.S.) per month, which is used for salaries, propaganda and other expanses and contributions. Following is a list of some of the regular monthly payments:

Sequests for financial assistance are received from other Cuban enigree such as former military and naval personnel and policesse. Often these requests are honored, on a one-time basis, and in a menner that will assure that they do not become personent financial obligations on the part of natista. Some publications are financed with Batista's mensy, such as the book <u>Historical</u> (hree Cubang by Mario History allorandon, a journalist, which was publicated in the latter part of 1938 at a sout of 52,000.

Batists deed not empribute a fixed arount of money to any emigre organization. Huwever, he does offer financial scaletance to individual sembore of organizations, particularly these of the Alianne Para is Libertad de Cuba (ALC, Alliance

- 6. At a meeting on 8 December Ruben Batista and Fernandes relayed Batista's instructions to a group of his followers who are exployed in the news movie. The instructions included the following:
 - a. The newspaper <u>Patria</u> must take a more moderate line. Attacks on agencies of the United States Government and on emigres who were formerly followers of Fidel <u>Castro</u> Ruz will no longer be published. The newspaper must adopt an attitude friendly toward the United States Government and its foreign policy.
 - b. Batists is pleased with the news program broadcast by Kramer and would like to increase the program from one half to a full hour. The expansion of this program is not for the purpose of enhancing Batista's stature, because he no longer aspires to return to Cuba in a position of power. He realizes that such aspirations would be unrealistic. Batista feels that the time that will be favorable for the liberation of Cuba is approaching, and he wants Cuban emigres to ge-double their efforts in working toward the liberation.
- 7. Among others who attended the 8 December meeting were Arnando <u>Garcia</u> Sifredo, editor and publisher of <u>Patria</u>, Alberto <u>Rodriguez</u> Rotger, almo of <u>Patria</u>, Kramer, Miguel Angel Antonio <u>Rianco</u> Cortina, a member of Kramer's editorial staff, Saif, and Santiago <u>Rey</u> Perma, a news commentator on radio station WMIE.

- 9. On 13 January Jose Ignacio <u>Rivero Hernandes</u>, former editor of the newspaper <u>Bl Diario de la Marina</u> in Cuba, Baid he is planning to publish a newspaper which will be called <u>Foto</u> <u>Impresiones de la Marina</u>. Montaner will assist Rivero in this ondeavor. The newspaper will be financed by Battsta. Rivero opined that when this newspaper is established, <u>Patrin</u> will no longer be published.
 - 1. Source Comment. Followers of Batista ("Betistianos") fall into two categories: (1) those who are directly associated with Batista, are employed by him, and receive instructions from him or his intermediaries; and (2) those who were formerly connected with his administration and, even though they are no longer directly associated, they remain loyal to him.
 - 2. <u>Field Comment</u>. Source has also reported that Ferrandez' wife, Adela, is Saif's sister.
 - 3. <u>Source Comment.</u> Cobas, Gonzalez, Guas and Sirgo are also journalists and radio commentators. Pizzi was at one time employed by the newspaper <u>Mundo Americano</u>, a job which he received on Batista's recommendation.
 - 4. <u>Field Comment</u>. An independent source reported that Piedra left the United States for Spain during the week of 16 to 22 January. He went at Batista's invitation. In mid-December another usually reliable source reported that it was runored in the emigre community in Miami that Piedra and Laurent (fnu) were to meet with Batista in the mear future, after they had concluded an agreement with Aureliano <u>Sanches</u> Arango whereby Sanches and his group would cooperate with Batista in an effort to overthrow Castro, Laurent is probably identical with Julio 8. <u>Laurent</u> Rodrigues, forser Cuban Chief of Naval Intelligence. 1. During the reporting period AMCLATTER/1 has continued to serve as contact point for matters pertaining to Cuban exile activities and related affairs of possible CI interest. lle has maintained his large number of contacts within the Cuban exile community, contacts representing such varied sectors as exile political leaders, officials of exile organizations, former mem-bers of the police force, as well as suspected underworld characters. AMCLATTER/1's close relationship to Identity A has resulted in a number of reports which were of interest to other Station components and some of which were disseminated. AMCLATTER/ is at his best when asked to furnish information about individuals in the WAVE area who may be of operational interest to the Station; he parsues such assignments with the zeal of a trained bloodhound, combing his many and various contacts for information and rarely coming up with a negative report. AMCLATTER/1 works diligently and likes to be kept busy. It is preferable to give AMCLATTER/1 highly specific and detailed instructions, which he will then follow to the letter. When left to his own devices he will at times not use the best operations! judgment, which is usually the result of over-zealousness and expediency rather than lack of operational know-how or experience.

2. In November 1965, with the increase in the refugee flow, the CI Branch began using the services of AMCLATTER/1 in interviewing refugees of interest to this Branch and preparing debriefing reports. In this respect he is performing the same kind of work as members of the AMSERVE Team. However, because of his continuing reporting on Cuban exile matter, his many contacts within this community, and the fact that he is known to be in touch with KUBARK among a large number of this


community, it was decided not to incorporate AMCLATTER/1 into the AMSERVE Unit but rather continue running him as a singleton agent. It was also felt that he responds more favorably under the direction and guidance of one case officer rather than as a team member. AMCLATTER/1 has performed very well in his new duties as refugee debriefer, and his debriefing reports are models of thoroughness, if not of organization.

3. During the reporting period October-December, AMCLATTER/1 conducted a total of 16 refugee debriefings and prepared reports on these. Some of the debriefings required as many as four separate messions. In addition, AMCLATTER/1 submitted ten operational reports dealing with information concerning the Cuban exile community, the majority of these stemming from contacts with Identity A. Two of these were disseminated.

4. During the period October-December 1965 the following funds were expended for AMCLATTER/1: Salary - \$1,344.87; reimbursement for POV mileage and operational expenses - \$209.44; total - \$1,554.31.

1. On 7 January 1966 AMCLATTER-1 reported the following information concerning recent activities of Roberto ALEJOS Arzu, wealthy Guatemalan emigre in Miami. AMCLATTER-1 got the information from his 19-year-old daughter, who in turn got it in conversation with Cristina ALEJOS, 19-year-old daughter of Roberto ALEJOS, during a visit to the ALEJOS residence on 5 January. The two young women are close friends.

a. Roberto ALEJOS has leased his house at 180 Palm Island Drive, Miami Beach, to an unknown person effective 15 January, for a period of one year. The ALEJOS family will move to another house owned by ALEJOS and located at 2395 North Meridian Avenue, Miami Beach, Telephone No. 538-3148. This house has been used as a guest house for relatives and friends from Guatemala visiting Miami. The house is currently occupied by Rafael CASTILLO Menocal (see copy of his card, attached), who is related to the Cuban MENOCALS.

b. CASTILLO arrived in Miami from Guatemala on 17 December 1965 for a two-week visit, extended since. A close friend or relative of ALEJOS, CASTILLO is

wealthy, in his early 50°s, well educated, and speaks Spanish, French, Italian, and English. He is deaf in his left ear. His daughters, who attended schools in Brussels, are also well educated and speak several languages. CASTILLO plans to return to Gualemala on 12 January 1966.

c. Cristina ALEJOS plans to leave for Guatemala on 15 January. For the past month her father has been training her on his properties in Guatemala about which she is to give him a report after her arrival there. Her father is particularly worried about "his large farm which is losing money." ALEJOS has indicated to Cristina that eventually she will take over control of all his property in Guatemala. She will stay with the CASTILLO Menocal family for three weeks, after which she will stay with her father's brother Arturo in Guatemala City.

d. Roberto ALEJOS does not plan to go to Europe this year because of the uncertain status of his financial affairs. He often speaks of his concern about the tense political situation in Guatemala and the danger of a Communist takeover. He is also concerned about his daughter's American boy friend, Arthur GORDICK (phonetic), who has had some problems in Guatemala involving the police. ALEJOS has forbidden Cristina to see GORDICK, but she is not complying with his order.





ON 8 JUNE 1965, ATON CONSTANZO PALAŬ, A FORMER CUBAN REBEL ARMY CAPTAIN WHO RESIDES AT 752 SW 4TH STREET, MIAMI, FLORIDA, SAID THAT HE HAS BEEN ENGAGED IN THE RECRUITMENT OF 60 CUBAN EXILES WHO ARE TO FIGHT IN THE DOMINICAN REPUBLIC. THE EXILES ARE BEING RECRUITED TO JOIN THE FORCES OF DOMINICAN GENERALS ELIAS WESSIN Y WESSIN AND ANTONIO IMBERT BARREPAS IN THEIR FIGHT AGAINST THE REBEL FORCES OF FRANCISCO CAAMANO DENO, AND ARE TO BE PAID \$50 A DAY FOR THEIR SERVICES. ALL OF THE RECRUITS HAVE A REVOLUTIONARY BACKGROUND BUT DO NOT INCLUDE FORMER MEMBERS OF THE FORCES OF FULGENCIO BATISTA. CONSTANZO SAID THAT HE HAS BEEN RECRUITING THESE MEN FOR A RICH DOMINICAN BUSINESSMAN WHO LIVES IN THE MIAMI AREA.

3. CONSTANZO SAID THAT IN ABOUT APRIL 1965 HE HAD RECRUITED SEVERAL CUBAN EXILES FOR ROBERTO ALEJOS ARZU, A GUATEMALAN MILLIONAIRE LIVING IN MIAMI BEACH, WHO WERE TO BE USED BY ALEJOS IN HIS ATTEMPT TO OVERTHROW THE GOVERNMENT OF ENRIQUE PERALTA AZURDIA. CONSTANZO STRESSED THAT THERE WERE POLITICAL COMMITMENTS INVOLVED IN ALEJOS' RECRUITMENT OPERATION, IN THAT THE CUBAN EXILES WERE TO BE PERMITTED TO ESTABLISH AN ANTI-CASTRO BASE OF OPERATIONS IN QUATEMALA IF THE ATTEMPTED OVERTHROW WERE SUCCESSFUL. (FIELD COMMENT: ALEJOS' ATTEMPTED OVERTHROW ABORTED IN EARLY MAY AND THE CUBAN EXILES DISBANDED. CONSTANZO HAD BEEN RECRUITED FOR THE OPERATION AS A TEAM LEADER.) IN THE PREBENT RECRUITMENT OPERATION, HOWEVER, CONSTANZO POINTED OUT THAT THE PRIMARY ATTRACTION IS THE \$700-A-DAY PAYMENT FOR SERVICES RENDERED.

1. AMCLATTER/1 reported on 19 April 1965 that he had received that same evening a total of four phone calls from an unidentified party threatening to kill both his wife and himself.

2. The first three phone calls were received between 1800 and 1830 hours whereas the fourth call was received at 2130 hours. The caller spoke fluent English and used extremely vile language insulting to both A/1 and his wife. The conversation during each phone call was short and made no sense to A/1 who said the caller at one point identified himself as Jerry WALKER when A/1 asked who was speaking. A/1 has never heard of anyone by this name and believes it to be fictitious. The caller also said on one occasion, "Fve been hearing the things you said about me up in Fort Lauderdale." Again, this remark made no sense to A/1. <u>NetThreatening that calles</u>

3. A/1, when offered by his JMWAVE C/O the use of a motel room or safehouse for the evening, said that he appreciated our offer but was armed with a 38 caliber revolver and could take care of himself. He said that his wife and 18 year old daughter agreed with him about staying in their own house since they had fled their home once before in PBRUMEN and did not intend to run again. A/1 is of the opinion that the caller is a crank but has not ruled out the possibility that it may be PBRUMEN intel inspired. He said that one of his friends (IDEN) also had recently received a number of threatening phone calls from someone who spoke fluent Spanish but refused to identify himself by name.

4. WAVE traces on WALKER are negative.
