MEMORANDUM FOR: FI/STC

SUBJECT: John McCORMACK Possibly Identical with John D. McCORMACK, aka Edward BROWDER, Jr.

1. This memorandum is written at the request of Mr. T. Karamessinos in connection with a preliminary dissemination, (OUT 92570), dated 22 November 1954.

2. Information was received in early October 1954 that one McCORMACK (FNU), an American in Honduras had written Senora Rosario FUERTALLANO and requested one and one-half million dollars for investment in the sugar industry in Honduras. Senora Rosario FUERTALLANO is a Filipina who reportedly heads a Philippine syndicate interested in investing large amounts of United States currency.

3. Upon querying ¹⁶⁻¹³ [the Honduran Station] the following information was received on one John McCORMACK ²¹⁻¹³ (TEGU/877 [IN 15239] 16 October 1954):

The only record of an American citizen named McCORMACK in the citizenship files of the State Department installation in Tegucigalpa was an application for registration of one John McCORMACK, dated 6 January 1953, containing the following data: Born 16 March 1902, at Millseat, Texas; Legal residence, 2140 East Mohave Street, Phoenix, Arizona; Occupation, civil engineer, Jones Construction Company. John McCORMACK resided in Panama 1942-1944; Ecuador, 1945-1947 and 1948-1951; Guatemala; 1947-1948; and Saudi Arabia 1951-1952. John McCORMACK was released from employment with the Jones Construction Company and reportedly returned to the United States in March 1954, according to information given to a Department of State employee by an employee of the Jones Construction Company.
