John McCORMACK Fossibly Identical with John D. McCORMACK, aka Edward BROWDER, Jr.

le This memorandum is written at the request of Hr.T.Karamessines in connection with a preliminary dissemination, (OUT 92570), dated 22 November 1954.

- 2. Information was received in early October 1954 that one McCCRMACK (FHU), an American in Honduras had written Senora Rosario FUERTALIANO and requested one and one-half million dollars for investment in the sugar industry in Honduras. Senora Rosario FUERTALIANO is a Filipina who reportedly heads a Fhilippine syndicate interested in investing large amounts of United States currency.
- 3. Upon querying the Honduran Station the following information was received on one John McCORMACK (FERT 877 /IN 152397 16 October 1954):

The only record of an American citizen named McCORMACK in the citizenship files of the State Department installation in Tegucigalpa was an application for registration of one John McCORMACK, dated 6 January 1953, containing the following data: Born 16 March 1902, at Millseat, Texas; Legal residence, 2140 East Hohave Street, Phoenix, Arizona; Cocupation, civil engineer, Jones Canstruction Company. John McCORMACK resided in Pansma 1942-1944; Equador, 1945-1947 and 1948-1951; Guatemal 2 1947-1948; and Saudi Arabia 1951-1952. John McCORMACK was released from employment with the Jones Construction Company and reportedly returned to the United States in March 1954, according to information given to a Department of State employee by an employee of the Jones Construction Company.
