- 37. First introduced to James E. Palmer and Wallace A. Growery by a contact of Palmer's in May 1957. Has been under development since that time.
- 38. Yes. Is any mature bilingual case officer.
- 39. He is politically ambitious and realizes the importance of good friendly relations with CDYNE and its representatives. He feels that by keeping CDYNE officials informed of his plans and revolutionary/political endeavors, he will have the blessing and possible assistance of CDYNE in the event he is successful.
- 40. Cuban Department of Investigations, 30 July 1957. Numerous references for anti-Government (BATISTA) activity. Embassy and station files - no derogatory. Biographical information has been verified from Embassy records.
- 41. Negative control only. His desire for CDYNE understanding and/or support in his political endeavors.
- 42. He knows his information goes to the CDYNE installation Habana and to their headquarters in PEPINE.

- 44. Information concerning political opposition plans including conspiratorial movements to overthrow the Government. He is best qualified to furnish this type of information; and that which has been received to date is evaluated possibly true.
