SUBJECT: Contact With Sr. Manuel Antonio DE VARCEA 11 July 1951

VARONA would like \$1,000.00-\$1,500.00 to send these three men to New York and back to Mismi in connection with their efforts.

2. VAROWA also referred to a plan to send three Unbans, including a labor leader, on an anti-CASTRO mission to Latin America at a cost of about \$6,500.00 for each person.
