A Cuban emigre with excellent contacts is several emigre organisations in Missi. He has been an occurate reporter on those organizations and on general emigre political developments since about mid-1962.

- Representatives of the Hismi and Puerto Rico chapters of the Centro Cubano de Estudios Políticos (CCLP. Cuban Center for Polítical Studios) not in San Juan, Puerto Pico, on 20 August 1966) to start making plans to hold a CCLP congress. On the morning of 20 August; three delegates from Minni not with about six members of the Puerto Rico delegation for preliminary discussions on the agenda for the afternoon meeting. At this neeting Rufo Lopez Presquet, a leader of the Puerto Rico chapter, was consured for his irreconcilable position regarding the exclusiveness of the proposed congress. 3 Hanuel Pay Rivero, another member of the Puerto Rico branch, expressed concern that lopes' attitude would disrupt the preparations for, or jeopardise the effectiveness of the congress. Hay said that he is prepared to disband the Junta Revolucionaria Cubana (JURE, Cuban Revolutionary Junta), but will not do so until there is etsurance that the CCLP will become an effective organization. Lopez received applause when he addressed the group, and promised to refrain from creating difficulties for the CCEP, and to devote his time and energy toward making the congress 2 Success.
- The following agreements were reached at the afternoon meeting, which was attended by about 20 members of the Puerto Rico chapter and the three delegates from Himi:
  - a. The Congress Ravelucionario Cubano (Cuban Revolutionary Congress) will be held in Hismi from 2 to 5 February 1967.

- b. A "Esclaration of Principles" of the CCEP, which will set forth the purpose and goels of the organization, will be written.
- c. CCLF castero will be established in New York, Los Angelos, and Chicago, and in Caracas, Venezuela.
- 8. Her Lennick beneader, a dieni delegate, was designated to prepare a rejort on the results of the meeting which will be summitted to the Puerto Rico CCIP for approval after which a public approvantant on the position of the CCIP will be made.
- the CCLP is missi delegates went to Puerto Rico, the position of their organization on the topics which were to be discussed. It was agreed that the Missi chapter would favor holding a congress which would be solely for the purpose of consolidating and advancing the CCLP. The creation of a Partido de la Revolucion Cubana (PRC. Party of the Cuban Revolution), a proposed political party, should not be considered at the congress. In early August some members of the Puerto Rico chapter expressed their agreement with the position of the Missi chapter.

## Source Comments

- A "major problem" between Lorez and Ray appears to have been resolved after lengthy discussions, at which other members of the CCEP acted as mediators, in early August.
- 4. Although an earlier date was desired, the group was unable to agree on a date. Pay eald that a JURE rounion, which could not be postponed, was scheduled to be held during the third week of Hovember. December was not considered because of the holidays, and, following that, January is spent paying all of the Christuss bills."
- 5. All members of the CCEP will be eligible to attend the congress. A representative of each of the two branches will determine who will be invited from areas where there are no CCEP chapters. CONFIDENTIAL

### Field Comments

- 6. Both the CCEP and the splinter proup which publishes Favolucion have discussed creating the PRC. The main difference appears to be in the timing. The CCEP feels that it would be presented to attempt to form a political party at this time, while the Favoration group, considered redical by the CCEP favors forming the party immediately. (Cf. UFG-8436, UFC-8443, and UFG-8477)
- 7. UFG-8976 incorrectly identified hunes as Enrique Hunes Gones, with the comment that he might be identical with a person by the same name who was formerly associated with the Second Hational Front of the Escantray (SFHL).

Available information indicates that Enrique Numes Alveres was also formerly associated with: the SPME. By early 1966 he was living in Puerto Rico and was associated with JURE.

- Tabala may be identical to Felix Tabala Mas who was a member of the SPNE-Alpha-16 in Puerto Rico, and supported Veglana's faction of that group.
- 9. Veciana is probably Antonio Veciana Slanch, a former leader of Alpha-66.
- 10. Quades may be identical to Emilio Guede who was reported to be a sember of the Exile Delegation of JURE in July 1965. He was believed to be identical with Emilio Quade Fernandes. (Cf. UPS-7471)
