02 On 28 December [VACCINE/1] told us that he had recently seen Grigori GOLUB for lunch when the latter asked [VACCINE/1] what he thought of the [RE]CORNING case and whether he had been able to ascertain if Reino HAYHANEN had ever been in Finland. [VACCINE/1] replied that he had been following the press reports with a good deal of interest. However, his organization has not been able to find any trace that a Reino HAYHANEN had been in Finland as claimed in the press. On getting this answer GOLUB went on to comment that the whole case was clearly a provocative fabrication on the part of the Americans.
