1. Reference is made to this office's CSCI-3/766,842, dated 9 August 1961, concerning the above Subject.

2. We have recently learned that KANTOR has returned to Copenhagen, Denmark from a trip to Yugoslavia, and that he plans to depart for New York in early September. He has recently been in daily contact with one William STRINSMITH, an American citizen born about 1933, who is currently living in Denmark without a residence permit. We have been advised by a usually reliable source that STRINSMITH has maintained a clandestine contact with a Cuban official in Copenhagen, and that he has sold pro-CASTRO articles to the local Danish press. We have also been advised that KANTOR recently obtained a check for \$1000, ostensibly from his father, to pay for his fare back to the United States.

3. We will forward to you any additional information we may receive in this matter. It is suggested, in the meantime, that it may be in order to ascertain, if possible, whether KANTOR's father has in fact recently acquired the above-mentioned sum and forwarded it to the Subject.

4. Our files contain no traces identifiable with STRINSMITH.
