Operational Message via JACETONE-1

Reference: MEXICO CITY 23202

1. In accordance with a policy decision to keep EKHERAL contact with U.S. business representatives discreet, a small luncheon was held in lieu of the customary formal briefings in the Headquarters building.

⁰² JACETONE-1, IDENTITY 1, David C. HIGBY and Floyd N. ALMONET attended the luncheon which was characterized by cordiality and candor.

⁰² JACETONE-1 stated until the conclusion of the meeting to raise his current favorite subject, that of countering the leftist propaganda contained in SIEMPRE. Fortunately, HIGBY was forewarned and effectively turned around the thrust of the effort upon JACETONE-1's shoulders, without offending him. IDENTITY impressed HIGBY with his interest, intelligence and sincerity. He offered his services of IDENTITY 2 to "do things" on our behalf but was convinced by HIGBY that the best way to approach the problem was through the use of individual members, rather than through IDENTITY 2 as an organization.

2. Discussions were held concerning Mexican affairs as well as Hemispheric trends. In the former category, our guests were most disturbed about the nationalization process in Mexico and enumerated
