- 6. George S. PERISTEROPCULUS aka PERIS, Identified above. and known to William H. MARTIN as "George PARIS", is identical with the individual whom Volentin HAEN aka Valentin Vasiliyevich KHAR aka won-thin HAN, admitted former (1947) Seriet agent, identified as "George PARIS, a Greek businessman in Tchyo", and as one of HANN's close contacts and friends in Japan. It has interviewed by representatives of this Agency to 1958. Valentine HARN advised that the above "George PARIS" was the person who introduced HARN to a Takwo mightclub, located off the Ginna, the name of which HAHN gave anly as "The Tomorrew Is Too Late Club". HAHN claimed that this was an exect and street translation into English of the actual Japanese name, which, bowever, he never mentioned during the interview. Date of HARN's visit to this "club" in company of George PERIS and PARIS, is estim-ted to have been communers between 1954 and 1957. HAMM stated that hi the "Temorrow is Too Late Club' be was introdeced to a Japanese hostess by the name of Northo MATSUZAKATA alias Northo AWAIL with whom HAHN subsequently enjoyed dates. It is believed that Noriko MATSUZAKAYA & AWAII became the mistress of Valentine HANV for an undetermined period of time following his original introduction to her at the above "Club" while in the company of Goorge PERISTEALPCULES ake PERIS ake PARIS. It is noted that the Takyo Telephone Directory for 1957 contains a listing for an octablishment of this name, as follows: ASU DE WA LBUSUCIAU, located at Chio-ku, Ginza, 8-Cheme, 3 Banchi, Tokyo-to, Tolephone Nec.: 57-9945, 57-6363, 57-6528. A reliable source, who is familiar with the city of Tokyo, advised in totober 1769, that as of 1759 this establishment was still operating at the listed location, and that it is a callee-house rather than a nightclub in the western senso, although alcoholic beverages are available for consumption on the premises by the pairous. The same source also advised that the above collee-house employs.
