ACTION REQUIRED: None; FYI

1. Subject was removed from SAC on 3 February 1968 and taken to a safe site where he was debriefed for some time. The purpose of the debriefing was to ascertain the subject's activities in Cuba and determining if he had any relationships with the KGB or any other Security organization.

2. During the course of the debriefing the subject appeared to be willing to cooperate and there were no indications of any attempt at deception. However, it is felt that the subject is a sharp operator, an opportunist and an individual who lives by his wits. He is very verbose, loud and attempts to hold the floor at all times.

3. CABELLANA claims that he had no relationship with the Cuban C-2, that he knew Pancho VALDERRAMA, Chief of the C-2 and Manuel PINELITO, Deputy Chief of the C-2, but that he never conducted any business with them. He stated that he knew many C-2 agents by sight but never knew their names. He is of the opinion that all members of the C-2 are Communists and individuals of very low caliber.

4. Subject was granted asylum in the Uruguayan Embassy on 06-06-
06 April 1967, which has remained until the present date.

by the Security Service. "Pajarito" does not know the exact date of birth of the subject. In view of all available information it is believed that the subject was born in 1925.

b. Subject admitted that during the last year he engaged in negotiations for the purchase of arms and combat fatigues. That during the month of September he traveled to San Francisco, California where he traveled under the name of purchasing arms from John F. MACE. It was during his stay of San Francisco that he purchased the arms from MACE but that he did make arrangements for the acquisition of elements of combat these arms from E. MACE. It is believed that the subject may have engaged in other criminal activities which he did not mention. This document is based on the information so provided in the attached Personal History statement regarding his travel and the short, temporary jobs he held in the past.

The subject also admitted that he was arrested on 26 April 1961 by the DSI because of his connection with a group engaged in the purchase and sale of US currency to the Cuban agents. According to subject he was a friend of RODRIGUEZ and subject was engaged in the purchase of false currency which he endeavored to take out of the country. The friends mentioned, Vicente Benito MIREL Hernandez and Luis Rodriguez Varela, were arrested by the Security Services. Similarly, JESUS J. and RODRIGUEZ informed the Security Services that the subject knew the whereabouts of RAMOS. Subject was arrested and asked to provide the address of RAMOS. Subject stated that he knew RAMOS and after being held for four days he was picked out by MIREL and RODRIGUEZ, who were released a few days before the release of Subject.

c. Subject denies any association with the Communist Party, CP or any other Security Service. He claims to be a true Communist and is willing to do anything in his power to combat Communism and liberate Cuba. Subject has no information of USSR interest and was returned to DSI for classification. The USSR does not contemplate any future contact.

d. JMWAVE traces reflect the following information on some of the individuals mentioned in this dispatch:

a. Eloy CUTIEREZ - Employee of American International. Subject of 26-261349; ~~RECORDED~~ 21 December 1960, 22 August 1961; ~~RECORDED~~ 1 September 1961; and 26-261349, 20 November 1961.

b. Aurelio SILVA - Possibly identical with Aurelio SILVA, former member of Cuban National Police. See 26-261349, 19 June 1961.

c. Domingo MENDOZA - Possibly identical with Domingo MENDOZA mentioned in HKUL-63-264, 26 October 1960.

d. General Genovevo PELLIZ Davera - believed to be identical with Genovevo PELLIZ Davera, one-time aide to staff of the Cuban Army. See HKUL-55-560, 26 October 1959.

There are no identifiable traces on all other individuals mentioned in this dispatch.
