**SUBJECT:** Information from (the British) in Answer to  
Question Re Identity of American who  
Allegedly Paid Manuel RAY's Fine in Nassau

1. (Chris Phillipotts) called at 1745/12 June 1964 to say that the (Governor of the Bahamas) had replied to our query as to the identity of the American who allegedly paid Manuel RAY's fine in Nassau (see TIME of 12 June 1964, page 48). The (Governor) stated that he saw no such figure and to the best of his knowledge there was no such person. The (Governor) also stated that he was discreetly checking as to whom Manuel RAY called in Miami from Nassau. The (British) will let us know the results of the check.
