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### BABORANDUM FOR THE RECORD .

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SUBJECT: Meeting with Manuel FAY in San Jose, Costa Fica

1. I met with Manuel LAY in San Jose, Costa Rica on 7 and 8 August 1964. The secting was routine; the business transacted is briefly summarized below.

## A. No Operations from U.S. Territory

I reiterated to SAY that it was our understanding that he would not launch any operations from U.S. territory. FAY understood and agreed to thin. no did say, however, that rumors of such activity could possibly reach us for the next few weeks instinct as it would take his now little while to reorient the activities and thinking of some of his fullowers.

### B. LAY Again Plans to Infiltrate tuba

AY hopes to infiltrate into Cuba within the next 10 to 20 days. This new silfert will be made from Jamaica. The exact point from which it will be made was not told ne, but it is supposedly from land eward by an American living in Jamaica and at a point approximately 50 miles from Cuba. The island of Jamaica itself lives more clowely to more than 100 miles off Cuba. FAY is again a little confused on operational details for his speaking of mome bit of land closer to Cuba that may actually fall within Jamaican Authority.
