1. Subject was born on 17 Korch 1913 in Now Orleans; Louisiana.

2. Standard background information on Subject (parants, marital status, records of education and exployment, otc.) in lacking because SHAN was a contact of the Demostic Contact Service.

3. Traces on Subject have been run in RID/Main Index, the index of the Office of Security and the Central Covar Staff. The first should only a 1951 FBI interview with SHAM about a former employee of the New Orleans International Trade Mart. The second showed that CO/Centacts Division had requested a name trace about 1949 and that the check of FBI records then conducted was negative. Central Cover Staff had no record.

5. On 9 May 1961 Génerol C. P. Cabell, then DDCI,001, . addressed the Foreign Policy Association of New Orleanspage. It is bolieved that he was introduced by Clay SHAR. MAR.

6. On 3 March 1967 the Machington Star reported to: that Carrison had arrested SMAM and had made public charges that SMAM, FERRIE, OSWALD, and others had plotted the assassination in the apartment of FERRIE at 3300 Louisiana Parkvay, New Griegans. SHAW has said that he never say OSWALD. He denies having used the name Clay BERTRAND. Jack S. MARTIN said that FERRIE had mentioned

8. Undated and unsigned neverandum (probably produced by CI/R & A). The following additional information was provided by the New Orleans office of DCS. 

9. On 7 March 1967 Pravda published an articlo called "Clay Shaw of the CIA" datelined Rows, 6 March 1967, written by V. YERMANOV. The article charged that CIA made use of the services of Clay SHAW for CIA's cua interests in Italy. The Pravda piece notes that the DA in New Orleans is accusing SHAW of participation in the assessmation conspiracy. It says SHAW spent "some years" in Form as a World Trade Conter Leader. It claims that the Conter was a cover for financing anti-formunist activity. CIA gave directives to SHAW. The World Trade Center was a branch of "Permiser" (sic), "which the newspapers in Mvitzerland openly secured of "criminal operations"..." (Compart: It appears that all of the Pravda charges are untrue, except that there was a CIA-SHAW relationship. So far as is known, SHAW was never asked to use his relation with the World Trade Center for clandestine purposes and, in fact, he has not been in Italy.)

19. Neuorandum from C/EUR/I to C/CI/R & A, 8 March 1967 subject: Italian Aspects of the Clay Shaw Affair, The Corrigio Balla Sora of 5 March 1967 has an article about SHAN, the assassination, and the World Trade Contor. Contains no relevant information.

11. A memorandum marked only for file 16 March 1967,57. signod M.D. Stevens, says that [J. Monroe CULLIVAN] 1260207...; Mas granted a covart security approval on 10 December 1963...; no that he could be used in Project [EXENCHANT. SHAW has the \$402097-A.
