RE SLOBODA CASE. WHILE IN LONDON MR. CUMBINCHAM DISCUSSED CASE WITH CUR STATICA THERE AND WAS AGAIN TOLD THAT BRITISH ASSISTANCE CAMBOT BE EXPECTED UNLESS ADDITIONAL REASONS THAN THOSE STATED IN ATTACHMENTS TO YOUR LETTER TO BSSO, DATED 11 SEPTEMBER 1960, ARE SUBMITTED.

THEREFORE REQUEST TO KNOW WHETHER DAD, GERMANY AUTHORIZED TRANSMIT YOUR LETTER OF 30 SEPTEMBER 1960 AND ATTACHMENTS TO ITS LONDON STATION AND HAVE LATTER USE SUBSTANCE PARAS 3 AND 4 OF THIS LETTER AS BASIS FOR REMEWING REQUEST FOR BRITISH ASSISTANCE.
