2. An anconfirmed report dated 15 May 1964 stated that Jose LAIN Martin Gonzalez, Cuban Vice Consul in Merida, Mexico, has been transferred from Merida. According to the local p. ess LAIN left Merida for Mexico City on 17 May 1964.

A 10 May 1964 report stated that Jose LAIN Martin Gonzalez and his family arrived in Mexico City on 17 May 1864 and left for Habana on 15 May 1964. According to a source of this Agency who is alresident of Mexico who has reported reliable information 24 for about three years, the Cuban Embassy instructed one Mariano GARCIA to cancel LAIN's lease and were forwarding money for his bills fince LAIN had not received his salary. This information indicates L...t the travel was sudden and possibly unexpected.
