1. It was Headquarters understanding that the transfer of MICHOFF's personal furniture to LICORAY-1 was going to be arranged as a matter between the persons concerned. The contractual arrangements between ADLANE and LICORAY-1 did not cover or contemplate furnishing of household items.

2. Reference A indicates that the station purchased the items listed therein from MICHOFF and furnished them to LICORAY-1 as of furniture. It is assured that when the contract with LICORAY-1 is terminated the furniture will revert to Station stock for future use.

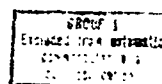

ACTION REQUIRED REFERENCES from an ODYCE Employee.

ACTION REQUIRED: Per paragraph 1

REFERENCE: ER 45-1c.(5)

1. Retroactive approval is requested for the procurement on 26 February 1965 of household furniture at a total price of \$286.00 from Natalie S. MICHOFF for use as QP furniture by LICOCKY-1.

2. The prices paid for the items as listed below are reasonable considering the condition, age, and quality and would have cost 300% more for equal items if procured on the Mexican local market. The items procured are as follows:

Living Room Suite (Sofa & 2 chairs)	\$ 76.00
Refrigerator	\$160.00
Beds, Hollywood twin and mattresses	\$ 50.00

3. It was felt at the time of procurement that since MICHOFF had resigned from her non-official cover position and that LICOCKY-1 was a contract agent, that the reference regulation did not apply. However, in view of the fact that both individuals either are or have been KUBARK employees, retroactive approval is requested to preclude possible audit exception in future audits. Should a similar transaction appear imminent in the future, prior Headquarters advice will be solicited.
