The following report is one of a series containing personality informatic - provided by the source and includes supplemental information from the records of this Agency.

It is requested that the addressees take no action on any of the individuals mentioned in the personality reports without first checking with this Agency.

1. Source identified a photograph of Rafael Francisco TAVERAS Rosario as being a Dominican and a member of the pro-Castro Agruption Política Catorce de Jurio (APCJ).

2. As a member of the APCJ, TAVERAS was originally sert to Caba to secure a scholarship in the Union of Soviet Socialist Republies (USSR). (However, source judges that when this schelership did not materialize, TAVERAS was put into the guerrilla warfare training program instead.) Source believes that TAVERAS was shill in Cuba at the time he left.

Headquarters Comment

1. Refael Francisco ("Fafa") TAVERAS Resarie, who was bern in about 1938, was elected secretary of publicity and propagarda on the APCJ Central Executive Committee in December 1962. Hc held that title when he left the Dominican Republic on 13 September 1963 for Mexico on a Spanish ship, on route to the Soviet SECRET NO FORN DISSEM
