The following report is one of a series containing personality information provided by the source and includes supplemental information from the records of this Agency.

It is requested that the addressees take no action on any of the individuals mentioned in the personality reports without first checking with this Agency.

- 1. Gines GORRIZ, pseudonym "Gil," is in charge of the British Guiana desk in the Seccion Sur (South American Section) of the Departamento de Liberacion Nacional (National Liberation Department - LN) of the Direction General de Inteligencia (General Directorate of Intelligence - DGI). In March 1964, he visited British Guiana. Source believes that GORRIZ was a member of the United States Army prior to 1959.
- 2. GORRIZ was described as having been born about 1934 and being five feet eight inches tall.1,2,3,4,5,6

Headquarters Comments

According to information acquired in September 1961 from an untested source who was formerly a G-2 member in the Cuban consular service, the co-ordinator for the 26th of July Movement. in Cuba was Gines GORRIN, who traveled frequently to New-York. GORRIN was the emissary between Cuba and SANCHEZ, President of the Movement in New York who had offices at the Hotel Belvedere and the newspaper Libertad.
