1. On 4 February 1965, AMMUG/1 was shown a photograph of Mikchail K. SAMOILOV, a Soviet diplomat, in an attempt to possibly identify FAMOILOV as "El Frances" who has been reported as the Soviet advisor to the Diretorio General de Inteligencia (DGI). AMMUG/1 thought the photograph was of a Soviet he had seen in Cuba but he could not state this definitely nor could he identify this individual as "El Frances".

2. The possible connection of the identity of "El Frances" with SAMOLLOV developed when his name appeared along with that of Manuel PINE/RO, Chief of the DGI, on a passenger manifest of a flight to Czechoelovakia. The manifest was forwarded to Headquarters as an attachment to OCOA-7878 dated 15 May 1964.
