PURPOSE: Project provides for a joint CIA/Mexican Government telephone tap center and for a nonofficial liaison relationship which provides access to the highest levels of the Mexican Government. All Soviet and Czechoslovak installations and major anti-U.S. elements are covered by the operation.

SS : Project has provided Station with a channel to the President of Mexico which is effective, rapid and covert, and was particularly worthwhile in making arrangements for President Kennedy's visit to Mexico in June 1962. The Mexican President was also briefed on the Cuban situation through this channel. The joint tap center provides coverage of 30 lines yielding positive and CI information of value. Division reports 236 positive disseminations on a variety of topics with concentration on Communist and anti-U.S. activity. A large amount of information not disseminated is used by other U.S. agencies in Mexico. The Station feels that this operation centributes greatly to the present friendly attitude of Mexican Government leaders toward U.S. policies.

FI operation employing audio surveillance and liaison-on-the highest government level

1. FI/LNT files contain 255 positive information disseminations produced by Project LIENVOY during calendar year 1962 -- 130 regular CS disseminations, 116 teletype reports on subjects of current or priority interest, and mine transmittals of official documents from Communist or leftist organizations in Mexico. LIENVOY reports provided information on the Mexican Communist Party (RCN), the Popular Socialist Party (PPS), the new but increasingly rewarful National Liberation Novement (MLN) -an anti-US, pro-Cuba Communist Front, on other Front or leftist organizations, and on individuals active in these organizations. Among the persons of intelligence interest most extensively reported on were Vicente LOMRAEDO Toledano, head of the PFS and an official in the World Federation of Trade Unions; Jorze L. TAMAYO Castillejos, an avowed Marxist appointed to a government position; Braulie MAIDONADO Sandez, Communist former governor of Baja California; the former president of Mexico General Lazaro CARDENAS del Rio, head of MLM; and General CARDENAS' son, Cuauhtemoc CANDENAS Solerzano. LIENVOY provided also information on Mexican contacts with Soviet Bloc countries, with Unda, and with leftists of other Latin American countries; on Communist and leftist publications; on Prensa Latina and other Cuban propaganda efforts in Mexico; on the reaction of Mexican and international Communists to the imprisonment of famed muralist David AIFARO Siqueiros, and their activities on his behalf. Valuable reporting in connection with President Kennedy's visit to Maxico was provided - Communist plans for sabstage, the Government's tactics to inhibit their fulfillment, and information on favorable reaction to the US President's speech expressed secretly by pro-Comminist members of the MIN. Among the disseminations which had to do with Cuba, a number reported the transshipment of goods, a subject of special intelligence interest and one, which reported the views of high-level government officials concerning the Cuban crisis, was described by CCI's analyst as extremely valuable.

2. The recently-issued (9 January 1963) FNIO cites as Third Category <u>Priority National Intelligence Colectives</u> the following to which LIENOY reporting is relevant: "The reaction of Latin American Governments and peoples to developments in and with respect to Cuba; the vulnerabilities of particular

The Traffic Department was staked out to determine who, if anyone, might show an interast in the names and addresses of the cars used by LP personnel. On the 16th of June, an agent of the Secret Curvice of the Folice Headquarters showed up and tried to obtain information about the owner of the license ; lates on LIENVOY-2's car. The stake-out employee and Secret Service ran checked the traffic files, but the information was not there. In conversation with the Secret Service man, information was gained which led the Station to suspect that he was a member of an investigative group headed by a Mexican whose atm is to obtain political information for Mexicon politicians. Since the 15th, no further attempts to place the LF under observation have been noted. Any problems such as this can be handled, if necessary, by the COS and his government contacts since this is a joint venture.

6. During the past project year, there have been 236 disseminations based on LIENTOY and LIENTOF42 information: 200 from the former and 30 from the latter. LIENTOY reporting covered such topics as:

7. WH Division supports the attached renewal request for Project LIENVOY submitted by the Mexico Sity Station. This project is considered one of the Station's most productive sources of positive, operational and SI information. Also, it provides a alandestine thannel to the President of Mexico for both the Station and the Ambassador.

REQUEST FOR PHOJECT LIENVOY REDEWAL

A. Current Objectives.

14-00000

The objectives of this project remain the same as those stated in the last renewal request. The project continues to provide the Mexico Station with a smooth and rapid channel to Mexico's highest political figures. The Principal Agent continues to be a close associate of Pres LOPEZ Mateos. The intercept center has undergone no major changes during the past year.

1. RFDM-6 Objectives Priority A, 1. a; Priority A, 4, a, b, c; and Priority B, 2 and 3 continue to be effectively covered by this project. Cordial and friendly relations continue between Government of Mexico leaders and the Chief of Station, Mexico. During the past year, the Chief of Station, Mexico, at the request of the Chief, ODACID, Mexico, has held a number of covert meetings with Aresident to convey ODYOKE policy matters. The Chief, ODACID, remains pleased with this access to Mexicon officials.

2. All Soviet and Czechoslovak installations in Mexico City are covered by this project. The Case Officer for Soviet Operations and the Case Officer for Soviet Satellite Operations rely heavily on this product for operational leads and data to support double agent operations.

3. All major anti-PBPRINE elements in Mexico City are covered by this project.

4. Targets of opportunity which appear to be hostile or critical to PEPRIME or to the present Government of Mexico are covered by this project.

All major objectives of the project are being effectively realized.

B. Changes.

At a yet to be determined date, it is planned to move the intercept center from its present location. Two reasons are behind this move: 1) security, since the present base has been used for almost three years: and 2) to provide the center with more mobile equipment. Such equipment is now under consideration by KURIOF and when it becomes available, an amendment to this project will be forwarded requesting approval for the transfer of the intercept center.

C. Intelligence Production.

The activities report forwarden to Headquarters each month lists the intelligence reports received from this project. During 1962 there were 534 intelligence reports produced by this project which were forwarded to Headquarters through 1 December 1962. All of these concerned RMDN-6 reporting priorities and current requirements levied by Headquarters and the ODACID installation.

In addition, this project produces a large amount of information which is not disseminated on a current basis but is reported to ODACID, ODENVY and other ODYOKE agencies in reply to a steady stream of routine file trace requests. These file trace requests run into the thousands each month. It would be difficult to determine the exact percentage of the information produced by LIENVOY; but in many instances involving prominent Mexican Government officials, large portions of the file came to us through LIENVOY coverage.

D. Effectiveness.

The LIENVOY project provides the Station with a channel to the highest level of the Mexican Government which is both effective and rapid as well as covert. The Station continues to receive the daily "resumen" highlights from the thirty (30) lines covered. A high percentage of current intelligence is discominated from these daily reports. In addition, full transcripts are received on Soviet and Czech lines and on any of the thirty targets we may request. A good part of this is personality data useful only to KUDARK and in some cases to QDENVY. In addition, the project provides a support mechanism for covering targets of interest to KUEARK or other ODYOKE agencies.

E. Problems.

There have been no significant security, cover, control or liaison problems during the past year.

F. Liaison.

From a liaison point of view, the Station believes that this project contributes greatly to the present friendly attitude of the Mexican Government leaders toward ODYOKE policies. The liaison remains clandestine in nature though contacts between the Chief of Station and Pres LOFE: Mateos are usually made at the request of the Chief, ODACID, Mexico.

G. Interagency Coordination.

The Chief, ODACID, Mexico, is the only ODYOKE representative in Mexico outside KULANK who is aware of this project. His role has been



explained above and the coordination with NUTANK is excellent.

H. Plans.

No significant operational changes are recommended for the next project year. Subject to the continuation of the present Mexican officials in their current positions, the project will not be changed.

I. Costs.

1. For the cast period.

The cost of the project (paid by Mexico Station exclusive of Headquarters costs) from 1 February 1962 through 30 June 1962 was US \$16,253.00 and from 1 July 1962 through 30 November 1962 (actual) US \$13,122.00 and \$7,600.00 for December and January (estimated). The total for the past year will be approximately US \$36,975.00.

2. For the next project year.

During the period 1 February 1963 through 31 January 1964, an estimated amount of US \$47,068.00 will be required with US \$1S,210.00 to be spont from 1 February 1963 through 30 June 1963 and US \$28,858.00 to be spont from 1 July 1963 through 31 January 1964.
