(FIELD COMMENT: DURING THE MORNING OF 14 NOVEMBER 1965, FIDEL CASTRO RUZ MADE A RADIO ADDRESS IN WHICH HE ACCUSED AGENCIES OF THE UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT WITH CARRYING OUT A RAID EARLIER THAT MORNING AGAINST SEVERAL TARGETS IN THE AREA OF MIRAMAR, HAVANA CITY. INCLUDING THE RESIDENCE OF CSVALOD DORTICOS TORRADO. ON 14 NOVEMBER THE 11:00 P.M. NEWS BROADCAST ON CHANNEL 7 IN MIAMI MENTIONED A STATEMENT BY JORGE MAS CANDSA, SPOKESMAN FOR RECE, IN WHICH MAS ADMITTED RECE PARTICIPATION IN THE RAID. - 5. SOURCE FOR PARAS 6 AND 7: A PROMINENT EMIGRE ACTIVIST WHO WAS FORMERLY A HAVANA YACHTSMAN. HE IS A PROMINENT FIGURE ON EMIGRE ACTIVISTS AFFAIRS. SOURCE'S REPORTING ON LOCAL CUSAN EMIGRE AFFAIRS HAS BEEN GENERALLY RELIABLE. THIS INFORMATION WAS OBTAINED FROM A CLOSE FRIEND OF LONG STANDING WHO IS ALSO A MEMBER OF COMANDOS L.
- 6. THE "ANGELINA" WAS DEFINITELY NOT INVOLVED IN THE 14 NOVEMBER RAID ON HAVANA. THE RAID WAS CARRIED OUT BY TWO VESSELS WHICH DEPARTED FROM THE MIAMI AREA AT AN UNDETERMINED DATE, AND WHICH HAD RETURNED TO THE MIAMI AREA AS OF 16 NOVEMBER. ONE OF THE VESSELS WAS A 22 FOOTER POWERED BY TWIN 210 HORSEPOWER CRYSLER ENGINES, AND HAD ABOARD HER CUESTA AS ONE OF HER CREW. THE OTHER VESSEL BELONGED TO RECE. TDCSDB 315/Ø1665-65, 15 MAY 1965) UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ORIGINAL ATTACK PLAN COMANDOS L WAS TO USE ONE SEABIRD MODEL VESSEL WHICH WAS TO BE THE STRIKE BOAT ARMED WITH A 3Ø CALIBER LIGHT MACHINE GUN AND ONE EIGHT-SHOT 2Ø-MM CANNON.
